The WIPRO TECHNOLOGIES were in Don Bosco College Campus at Angadikadavu for placement drive on 27-28 Jan 2014. This recruitment drive was only for students who were science graduates and undergraduates' from Colleges in Kannur district and around, passing out in 2014 with no standing arrears. WORKSHOP ON COMMUNICATION



At no time in life is the need for guidance more critical than in the transition from academic world to working environment; the choice of a job, adequate preparation for it, and the attainment of efficiency and success. A three day workshop on communication was offered for the final semester students of Social work at the Don Bosco College seminar hall on 13-15 March 2014. The workshop focused mainly on improving skills in English Communication. It was more of practice than theory with the students involving themselves in dialogues for different everyday situations and role-plays. Students were encouraged to speak at the same time exchanging partners after each interaction. In this way, they gained the advantage of maximum face to face interaction as well as continuous communication. Vocabulary building tasks were also given thus refreshing their memories with everyday words that otherwise they do not use every day. Amble exercises in dramatics enable the students to open up, emote and shed their ambitions. Students were made to think out of the box and broaden their perceptions by looking at social and moral case studies from different angles. A few common errors in English grammar were also corrected. All the participants, who appreciated the expertise and guidance of Mr. Sooraj Abraham, Career. Com, Aluva, Kochi who trained the group. It helped the students to gain the basic knowledge and skills they need to begin navigating their way successfully.

EMOTIONAL FREEDOM TECHNIQUE (EFT)

Department of Social Work, Don Bosco Arts and Science College, Angadikadavu, organized as a part of one month Competency Enhancement Programme for social work students, a workshop on EFT on 4 March 2014, by Fr. K. C. Thomas.

EFT is an emotional version of acupuncture wherein we stimulate certain meridian points by tapping on them with our finger tips. This addresses a new cause of emotional issues (unbalanced energy meridians). Properly done, this frequently reduces the therapeutic process from months down to hours and minutes. We sometimes achieve noticeable results as "one minute wonders". One of the astonishing things about EFT is that it can be applied to every emotional issue- including fear, trauma, grief, and so on with success. EFT eliminates barriers to forgiveness. EFT is a new, relatively painless, no drug procedure, and often works when everything else fails.

Fr. K C Thomas, the Director of Bosco Institute of Psychology and spirituality, Monvila, Trivandrum, has trained over 1000 people since 2004 and is one of the first to introduce EFT in India.

WORLD SOCIAL WORK DAY
