FOREWORD

NSS at Don Bosco Arts & Science College, Angadikadavu, Kannur University

The Winner of the Best NSS Unit, the Best NSS Programme Officer, and the Best NSS Volunteer Awards of Kannur University (2019-2020), Don Bosco Arts & Science College, Angadikadavu, upholds Social Responsibility as one of the key priorities in its official Value Charter: "We value committed service to the needy as an obligation." (www.donbosco.ac.in)

Since the NSS volunteers in the campus are widely recognized and highly esteemed by all, having a legacy of active and dedicated engagement in full-fledged social service projects, new students are on a cutthroat mode queuing up for a place in NSS. It is a Herculean task to select the volunteers from 280 applicants for a 100-member unit. As part of the selection process, the credentials of the applicants are verified through a written aptitude test, a social work assignment, a personal interview and two-day residential camp.

The greatest achievement of the NSS units at Don Bosco Arts & Science College, under the inspiring and dynamic leadership of our two Programme Officers, Mr.Nithin Kuttan P.K. and Jisha E is the construction of three houses (*SnehaVeedu*) for three homeless families, consecutively for the last three years (2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021).

The NSS volunteers launched 'Velicham', a specially-designed regular remedial coaching and tuition programme for the school-going tribal students at Eenthakari, a colony near Angadikadavu.

Another major venture involving financial backup was the *Midday Meal Programme* for the orphans at 'BalikaSadan' at Koottupuzha, with the students themselves contributing money and mobilizing the required fund to get the provisions for the inmates.

Yoga was made an integral part of NSS, organizing yoga workshops and seminars animated by experts for all the students in the campus. As part of the 'Fit India" programme, to make the students physically and mentally fit, samba sessions and follow-up activities were held.

The NSS unit at Don Bosco Arts & Science College was selected for the University level 7-day residential environment-oriented camp, *Urvaram*. Empowering the students to become proponents of environmental protection and sustainable development, conscientization programmes were organized at regular intervals, trees were planted with the support of the Forest Department, and 'plastic-free campus and town' was made a reality. Organic Farming was made a requisite, with the students cultivating and maintaining vegetable gardens in the campus.

During the days of flood in 2018 and 2019, NSS volunteers were fully engaged in the rehabilitation of flood victims in the relief camps, mobilizing fund, provisions and clothes, and cleaning up the houses for the people to re-settle when it was back to normalcy. During the months of Covid-19 pandemic especially when the lockdown had badly hit the poor, NSS volunteers supplied food packets of Rs.1000 each to 100 families in the neighboring areas.

The NSS unit organized Blood Donation camp in the campus every year and received the biggest donor award in Kannur district. Anti-drugs campaign was carried out in the campus holding awareness sessions, and in the towns with street plays and rallies, holding placards.



The NSS volunteers are the most disciplined students in the campus, always available for any work, eager to become partners in all social service initiatives, very reliable in the fulfillment of responsibilities entrusted to them, and are the great assets of our college.
